

With Mass beginning on May 10, there are a few guidelines from the Bishop we will need to follow:

- 1. All hymnals and missalettes are to be removed.**
- 2. Ushers and other volunteers are to wear masks and gloves throughout the celebration of Mass.**
- 3. Everyone should maintain a 6 ft distancing when entering and exiting church.**
- 4. Entry doors are to be propped open so the doorknobs won't be handled.**
- 5. Seating should be arranged so families will sit 6 ft from each other.**
- 6. There will be a stationary basket for collections, no basket will be passed during this time.**
- 7. During communion, everyone is to maintain 6 ft distancing in line.**
- 8. There will be no Holy communion from the Chalice. Please make special arrangements with the Pastor if you are gluten free.**

9. Holy communion will only be given in the hand. When approaching the Communion minister, the communicant is to pull their mask below their chin and present one hand resting on the palm of the other. After responding "Amen" the communicant reverently places the Eucharist in his or her mouth and immediately replaces their mask.

10. Ushers will not hand out bulletins so pick one up as you leave.

11. the church will be wiped down and disinfected.
